EuroKids plans to set up more schools in 5 years

EuroKids International Pvt Ltd, which runs a network of 1,100 pre-schools and 34 high schools in key cities, has drawn up a plan to grow to 3,000 pre-schools in five years. The company has decided to run more high schools in Mumbai, Pune, Bengaluru and Hyderabad.

“All this will involve an investment of ₹400 crore in five years. We will fund this through internal sources and debt,” said Prajodh Rajan, executive director & Group CEO of EuroKids International Pvt. Ltd.

Mr. Rajan said, “We took 17 years to open the first 1,000 pre-schools, now we will add 2,000 more in five years. Our plan is to have a total of 100 high schools in the next five years.”

The company is also making its foray into day care centres to enable corporates to comply with the government’s provisions on Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017. It has opened 22 day care centres for large corporates and plan to have 300 high quality day care centres in three years.
